

Summary of Modifications to SMART in Version 10.6.1
Release Date October 9, 2009

This table summarizes the major changes for users in SMART Version 10.6.1.

Several modules change in the new version to provide greater functionality to the user, as summarized below.

Module Affected	Description
Client List	SMART now allows the user to view additional clients with consents from outside agencies on the Client Search screen.
BSAS Scheduler	There are enhancements for the BSAS scheduler, which is available only to BSAS agencies. These enhancements allow deletion of recurring but unfilled appointments, as well as other features.
BSAS Reports	BSAS reports are now available for additional BSAS agencies, as long as a user has BSAS privileges.
Department of Juvenile Services (DJS) Needs Assessment	The DJS Needs Assessment is moved to the Client level, meaning that it is not associated with an intake (episode of care). Therefore, it will not appear on the Client Activity List, but is available for a specific client from the left hand menu tree. There are also changes to some of the graphs.
Department of Juvenile Services (DJS) Treatment Plan	The “Finish” button on the Treatment Plan Overview and Diagnosis screens now directs the user to the Treatment Plan profile. The “Finish” button on the Treatment Plan profile now directs the user to the Client Activity List.
DTMS	There are several changes to the new automated drug testing management system, which will be released to two agencies this fall.
Admission (for ADAA/treatment)	ASI or POSIT scores are no longer required on the Admission record (treatment admission reported to ADAA). These fields are no longer yellow, and, if omitted, no longer trigger the “incomplete record” status.
