

**Summary of Modifications to SMART in Version 12.0 (September 2010 Release)
Release Date October 15, 2010**

This table summarizes the major changes for users in SMART Version 12.0.

Several modules change in the new version to provide greater functionality to the user, as summarized below.

Module Affected	Description
Encounters, Treatment Plan, Group List	CPT codes are now labeled as “services” both on screens and on reports.
Continuing Care Check-up, Recovery Plan	From the Continuing Care Check-up overview and the Recovery Plan overview screens, users can now add a recovery team member or review existing members.
Continuing Care Recovery Plan and Continuing Care Recovery Review	These modules are renamed to “Recovery Plan” and “Recovery Plan Review.”
Encounters	Users can now search for encounters which meet a certain outcome code, such as “attended,” “FTA,” or “excused.” Also, when users export encounters, “outcome” and “payment source” are now included on the data export.
ADAA export and SSA reconciliation	This release corrects a difficulty with exporting ADAA data.

Some modules are added for future use. Training and implementation details will be provided at a later date.

Module Affected	Description
DJS Treatment Service Plan	Changes were made to the TSP to better meet the needs of DJS. This module will be released to DJS at a later date.

Some changes affect only users at the MD Department of Juvenile Services, as summarized below.

Module Affected	Description
DJS Needs Assessment	Recommended level of supervision is modified when risk level is high and other conditions exist. The offense “violation of probation” is added to the offense listing for question 14 of the Delinquent History Domain.
