

**Summary of Modifications to SMART in Version 12.1 (October 2010 Release)  
Release Date November 19, 2010**

This table summarizes the major changes for users in SMART Version 12.1.

**Several modules change in the new version to provide greater functionality to the user, as summarized below.**

Module Affected	Description
<b>Recovery Care Check-up</b>	When the user saves a continuing care check-up (it does not need to be complete), there will now be a “Create Encounter” link at the bottom of the check-up. Clicking this takes the user directly to the Encounter screen to document this check-up. The encounter will pre-fill to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Note type – Case management</li> <li>• Rendering staff – User who is logged in</li> <li>• Start time – Start time that Continuing Care Check-up was begun in SMART</li> <li>• End time – End time of Continuing Care Check-up in SMART</li> <li>• Date – Date of Continuing Care Check-up</li> <li>• Payment Source - DHMH Grant ADAA</li> </ul>
<b>Enrolling in Assessment Programs</b>	Clients who are not admitted but are enrolled in an Assessment program may now have encounters documented in SMART.
<b>Client Profile</b>	Four new types of collateral contacts were added, as follows: DJS Community/aftercare Case Manager, DJS Community Detention Worker, DJS Residential Case Manager, and DJS Family Intervention Specialist.

**Some modules are added for future use. Training and implementation details will be provided at a later date.**

Module Affected	Description
<b>DJS Treatment Service Plan</b>	Changes were made to the TSP to better meet the needs of DJS. This module will be released to DJS at a later date.

**Some changes affect only users at the MD Department of Juvenile Services, as summarized below.**

Module Affected	Description
<b>DJS Needs Assessment</b>	Small changes to the first page of the report for both reassessments. Signature lines are moved to the end.
