

**Summary of Modifications to SMART in Version 12.4 (January 2011 Release)  
Release Date February 18, 2011**

This table summarizes the major changes for users in SMART Version 12.4.

**Several modules change in the new version to provide greater functionality to the user, as summarized below.**

Module Affected	Description
<b>Encounters</b>	The procedure for creating an encounter has been optimized. Users will notice that encounters now save more quickly for clients with a large number of encounters.
<b>Discharge (Treatment)</b>	The informational message that users receive when discharging a client now uses the most recent Encounter Start Date as the last encounter date. SMART will use this latest encounter whether the service was attended or not. However, users may always enter an earlier discharge date if the service was FTA or excused. This is solely an information message.
<b>Group Notes</b>	Group notes now use the correct client program enrollment association on the group session screen.
<b>eCourt Admission</b>	This version modified the way the screen operates so that the screen no longer refreshes upon entering or editing any of the four prior convictions fields. Therefore, screen performance is improved.
<b>Treatment Plan</b>	Users may now modify an active treatment plan from the treatment review link without any system issues.
<b>Referrals</b>	A client may now only be referred once to a facility within an agency. If a user attempts to re-refer the same client to the same facility, SMART will not allow it and will give the user an error message. If a client was previously referred and the referral was terminated or rejected, and the client needs to be referred again, the referring agency should change the referral status to “created/pending” to re-activate the previous referral.
<b>Treatment Review</b>	Adding a treatment review record when there was a previously completed record sometimes caused a yellow screen. This issue has been resolved.
<b>Recovery Plan</b>	Fixed an issue that displayed a yellow screen if a menu item under “Recovery Plan” was selected while on the overview screen.

**Some modules are added for future use. Training and implementation details will be provided at a later date.**

Module Affected	Description
<b>Access to Recovery functions (ATR3)</b>	New modules are added to enable Maryland to use SMART to track ATR clients, vouchers, etc. Only a few agencies will be using these modules and ADAA will notify these agencies and arrange for training.

**Some changes affect only users at the MD Department of Juvenile Services, as summarized below. These are for future use – training and implementation details will be provided at a later date.**

Module Affected	Description
<b>DJS Treatment Service Plan</b>	Many additional features and modifications are applied to the TSP.
