

**Summary of Modifications to SMART in Version 12.6 (March 2011 Release)  
Release Date April 15, 2011**

This table summarizes the major changes for users in SMART Version 12.6.

**Several modules change in the new version to provide greater functionality to the user, as summarized below.**

Module Affected	Description
<b>Client List</b>	When searching for clients, clients who met the search criteria and had consents only or consents and accepted referrals from outside agencies used to appear at the bottom of the screen, under “Clients with Consents from Outside Agencies.” Now, if a client was accepted via a referral into the agency performing the client search, the client will no longer appear under “Clients with Consents from Outside Agencies.” Instead, the consented activity will be available from the “Linked Consents” hyperlink found next to the “Activity List” hyperlink on the Search Results List.
<b>Client List (Linked consents)</b>	“Linked Consents” hyperlink now appears to the right of “Activity List” hyperlink on the Client List. If the client was referred by another agency and accepted by this agency, or the client had a linked consent manually created in SMART, this linked consents hyperlink will pull up the client’s consented activity list.
<b>Admission (Treatment)</b>	Make “Actual Level of Care” no longer light yellow (meaning required for ADAA reporting). Make “Recommended Level of Care” light yellow (required for ADAA/state reporting).
<b>Agency Reconciliation</b>	Include the extended TEDS/NOMS data (entered in the program enrollment) in the download. Also, include updated client profile information if a client profile was submitted previously and change. Add “Recommended Level of Care” from the Admission to the download. Remove “Actual Level of Care” from the download.
<b>Client Progress Report</b>	Optimize the Client Progress Report so it will run more quickly in large agencies.
<b>Treatment Plan</b>	Users will now receive a message that “You must save or cancel your changes first” when trying to add a goal without first saving on the Problem Profile screen.

**Some modules affect only agencies involved with Access to Recovery, as summarized below.**

Module Affected	Description
<b>ATR</b>	Authorization Change Request screen has been turned on in Maryland for ATR Authorizations.

**Some changes affect only users at the MD Department of Juvenile Services, as summarized below.**

Module Affected	Description
<b>DJS Treatment Service Plan</b>	Modify language on some existing fields and add new fields the DJS Treatment Service Plan/Placement & Permanency screen, Treatment Service Plan Profile, and Planned Services Screen to comply with Title IVE Requirements.
<b>DJS Treatment Planning</b>	Modify the field labels and add new field labels to the DJS Treatment Service Plan Output Report to

match the modifications made to the screens (see: 8512, 8514 and 8629).

Bug fixed to allow a Court Ordered Condition to be saved without requiring an “Actual Achievement Date”.
