

Summary of Modifications to SMART in Version 13.3.1 (December 2011 Release)
Release Date January 13, 2012

This table summarizes the major changes for users in SMART Versions 13.3.1.

Several modules change in the new versions to provide greater functionality to the user, as summarized below.

Module Affected	Description
User Accounts	Users are now asked to create a security question if their account does not have one. Then, if users forget password or PIN, a new temporary password and PIN will be emailed to users if the user correctly answers the security question.
Treatment admission and discharge	The Tobacco Screen has been added to both admission and discharges for treatment providers. Data elements included are: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Have you ever used Tobacco/Nicotine Products? • Smoker Status • At what age did you first use tobacco/nicotine products(s) • In the past 30 days, what tobacco/nicotine product did you use most frequently? • In the past 30 days, how often did you use tobacco/nicotine products(s)? • In the past 30 days, how many cigarettes did you smoke per week?
Encounters	A section to document interventions used during progress toward goals in the SMART treatment plan has been added to the encounter notes. All goals for the time period of the active treatment plan are available for selection on the encounter note. However, when a goal is selected, only the related objectives display for selection and when an objective is selected only the related intervention is displayed.
Treatment Review	When a treatment plan review is performed and the reviewer attaches comments about the treatment effectiveness or progress towards the stated goals by selecting values from the drop down fields on the treatment plan review page, these values are now displayed in the Treatment Plan Review Outline page and on the Treatment Plan Review print report.
Discharge (from treatment)	For users with Agency Administrator or WITS Administrator roles, an administrative action appears at the bottom of the discharge screen profile for “Delete Discharge.” This is available if the discharge is saved and the intake is open.
ATR Encounters	For ATR encounters signed and unsigned notes boxes have been added to the encounter screen. ATR encounters will require a signed note. The “Allow Disclosure” action for notes defaults to “Yes.”
Payor Adjudication	The payor adjudication process has been automated for ATR provider claims.

GPRAs Follow-up Due Alert	SMART now allows a separate GPRAs Follow-up Due Alert to be put into place which will alert certain users that follow-up GPRAs are due.
Billing Transaction Report	A new Billing Transaction Report is available which is not subject to the 1000 record limit.
ATR intake date	ATR intake date now gets set as Referral Date and not Referral Accepted Date.

Some changes affect only users at the MD Department of Juvenile Services, as summarized below.

Module Affected	Description
Needs Assessment	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Modify the rules such that a reassessment may not be created unless there is a needs assessment and it is associated with an active, open supervision episode. 2. Any needs assessment may be associated with a supervision episode, as long as it is not associated with another supervision episode.
DJS Treatment Service Plan	Bug has been fixed where the radio buttons for the Family Domain questions 2b and 2c are now displaying.
DJS Treatment Service Plan	Needs Assessment - the Needs Assessment has a lock button that allows a DJS Supervisor to "lock" the assessment and make it read only. It may also be unlocked. Additionally, the assessment is automatically locked when associated with a supervision episode, but can be unlocked by a DJS supervisor.
