

Summary of Modifications to SMART in Version 13.6.0 (March 2012 Release)
Release Date April 20, 2012

This table summarizes the major changes for users in SMART Version 13.6.0.

Several modules change in the new version to provide greater functionality to the user, as summarized below.

Module Affected	Description
Encounter reports	Outcome is now added as a column on all Encounter Reports. This includes the Encounter list Excel report as well as the Encounter Data reports found in the Reports Module.
Client Outcome Measures	The Client Outcome Measure module is now available in SMART. It can only be used if there is a treatment admission.
Drug Testing Management System	Optimized performance on Appointment search and Staff search.
GPRAs Follow-up Due	Added a new facility drop-down field to the search section of the GPRAs Follow-up Due screen which allows the user to filter their search criteria by facilities available under the selected Agency. Also added a facility column to the list that displays the facility that the GPRAs Follow-up is associated with.
Client Profile GPRAs	<p>The “State” dropdown in the Address Information on the Contact Info page now defaults to MD. New Violence, Trauma and Military Families questions have been added to sections A and F of the GPRAs Intake, Discharge and Follow up interviews for ATR. These questions will be displayed for GPRAs interviews conducted on or after 4/2/2012. Any interview conducted prior to this date will show the new fields read-only and pre-populated with the value “Interview Before Question Added”.</p> <p>Questions 2, 3, & 4 in Section C for GPRAs Follow-ups & Discharges are now editable when alcohol and/or drug use is indicated among the questions in Section B</p>
Encounters	Changes the error message when an error is created upon “Release to Billing” to be more informative. Also, the Released to Billing Date field on released encounters now displays both date and time.
Voucher	Users with the Authorization (Full Access) role are now able to reopen a closed authorization/voucher even if the user's agency didn't create the voucher (the agency is not the Administering Agency of the voucher).

Some changes affect only users at the MD Department of Juvenile Services, as summarized below.

Module Affected	Description
Supervision History	The issue with the Supervision Level yellow page has been corrected.
Treatment Service Plan	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. The treatment plan must now be complete before the plan can be signed off.2. The title “Planned Services” has been added to the TSP Planned Services screen in the blue bar area.3. The Diagnosis Summary field on the Substance Abuse screen will now allow entry of up to 256 characters.4. Contacts Outcomes table was loaded. “FTA” has been changed to “No Show,” “NA” is expired, and “Unexcused” has been added.
Needs Assessment	The error messages on the needs assessment have been modified to be more specific regarding the Supervision Episode status.
