

Summary of Modifications to SMART in September 2012 (14.0) Release
Release Dates September 21, 2012

This table summarizes the major changes for users in September 2012 SMART Release.

Several modules change in the new version to provide greater functionality to the user or to correct previous issues, as summarized below.

Module Affected	Description
Client Group Enrollment	Corrected a bug where users were unable to delete an End Date for Government Contract Enrollments.
Code Table Editor	Added a column to the Staff Type code table so that the user can indicate whether the staff is a clinical staff or non-clinical staff.
Encounters	Previously, staff credentials, which show in the staff dropdown, did not display in the signed note. The process has been modified so that the credentials of the 'signed by' staff member will also display in the signed note.
Contract List	Previously, the Status on Contract List search was blank upon entry. Going forward, it will be pre-populated with Active.
Consent	The values available for selection in the "Disclosed to Facility" dropdown now conditionally auto-populate upon selecting a value for "Entities with Disclosure Agreement". Also, a selected "Disclosed to Facility" will now be cleared upon changing the selection for "Entities with Disclosure Agreement" or "Disclosed to Agency".
Staff Assignment	In work item #12559 in the July 2012 release, FEI changed the behavior so that staff could not remove approved facilities from other staff accounts if the person logged in did not have permission for those facilities themselves. This was incorrectly applied to WITS Admin and Oversight(Full) staff such that they were prevented from removing facilities for staff accounts in agencies other than their own. WITS Admin and Oversight(Full) staff can now add or remove approved facilities for staff accounts that are not registered in their home agency.
Intake, Program Enrollment, and Admission	Do not allow entry of future dates.
Assessment (SOGS)	If the answer to the first question of the SOGS indicates that the client has never gambled, all other fields on

the SOGS are read only and not required.

Code Table: A dropdown column was added to the code table editor screen for ASAM Care Level. This dropdown column pre-populates with all non-expired values from the Modality type table.
