Summary of Modifications to SMART in Version 9.1.1 Release Date – September 2008

These two tables summarize the major changes for users in SMART Version 9.1.1. Please see the detailed User Release Notes pages, included in this document, for additional information.

I. Six modules change in the new version to provide greater functionality to the user, summarized below.

Module Affected	Description
Court Monitoring 8-507	When the user chooses an Agency in this module, all active agency names in SMART will now
Treatment Placement *	appear in the drop-down box.
Referrals In*	"Referrals In" now shows additional information for each referral. SMART now displays the SMART Client ID, the client's date of birth, and the referring agency in addition to the information previously displayed.
Intake	The "Special Initiative" is no longer a required (yellow) field.
Client Activity List*	Drug test results are now grouped on the Client Activity List. To access individual drug test results, the user will choose the summary activity and then select individual tests.
Medications (under	Date of admission to buprenorphine medication administration is no longer required, when
Treatment)	documenting or changing dosage or frequency.
Client Profile	SMART will now close Client Group Enrollment (if the user did not do so manually) when a case is closed on the Intake screen.


II. There are changes which correct issues in the previous version, as detailed below.

Module Affected	Description
Intake	This version of SMART will no longer allow a client to have more than one episode of care open in a
	facility at the same time. To make changes to a closed case, the user will first need to close any open
	case. The user can close and re-open cases as needed, but only one case can be open at a time.
ASI	When there is a consent to share ASI interviews between agencies, agencies will be able to access the
	raw data entered by the consenting agency and the ASI Report. The Client Narrative Report in PDF
	format will no longer be available.
Client Progress Report	The "Date of Last Positive" will now report the last positive drug test in any consenting agency.
Client Intake and Profile	The ability to delete an intake and profile, if there are no other activities for a client, is temporarily
	suspended. The capability will be restored shortly. (This privilege was granted to only a few users.)




Description: Referrals In now shows additional information for each referral, including SMART Client ID, client's date of birth and the name of the referring agency.
